Dear Kim:

I am twenty-three years old and have been crossdressing for about ten years. I started sneaking things out of my sister's room when I was thirteen. Whenever I was left alone I would dress up in whatever I could find around the house. Eventually I bought a few things of my own. This was all a secret until I graduated from high school and went to college. As soon as I got away from home I acquired a complete wardrobe and began to dress up as a girl regularly. Before long I was going out in public.

I am slender and effeminate as a male (5'7" tall, 110 pounds), so becoming a girl was not a physical problem, although my nose was too big and my hands are larger than I would like. I had to work a long time to learn the mannerisms and speech patterns but it comes eventually with daily practice.

About the middle of my freshman year I decided to go full time as a woman. It was a big decision. I knew my family would be very upset and I expected the college officials would object. I got together with a minister who understood my desires and helped me a great deal in this troubled time. Together we were able to convince my family that the change did not mean the end of the world for me or for them. My mother and sister were sympathetic but my father found it harder to take. After a little while he became more accepting and now there is no problem with my parents. And, little by little we have managed to tell the relatives. Some accept me and some do not.

At first I wanted to have an operation as soon as possible, but a transsexual counseling service convinced me that I

should wait and try things out for at least a year. It was good advice.

When I began showing up for classes in a dress the Dean of Students called me in. I was attending a small college with a conservative religious affiliation. Needless to say they were not thrilled about having a person of my sort on campus. This time my minister friend could not overcome the school's prejudices. They asked me to leave at the end of the school year, but I was permitted to wear whatever I liked to classes. Many of the students, particularly the girls, supported me. But, it was not a pleasant experience. I started hormone therapy and, of course, this meant emotional and physical changes. By the end of the term my hair had grown long and full and I was feeling good about my new self. I went home for the summer and stayed with my parents at their summer cottage on a lake. It was just the sort of rest I needed and read a lot, learned to sew, and got to know myself better.

My grades at college had been good in spite of all the problems so the next fall I was able to transfer to the state university where I enrolled in the school of fine arts. I studied dance and music composition for three years and graduated with a BA. I was more accepted at the university although my situation became public knowledge because some students from the college blabbed about it. This meant some unwelcome attention but I had many understanding friends to turn to.

During this time I became completely feminine. I had my ears pierced and grew my hair to below the shoulders. The hormones made my skin clear and soft and I developed a nice bosom. I kept my narrow waist

and added some weight to my buttocks. I had several casual relationships—first with girls and then with men. Some of the men realized I was a she-male. There was no sex—just some petting. I did experience sex with a lesbian girl but the affair was very brief.

During the summer I worked as a secretary in the office of one of my music professors. He was gay and we had many discussions about our common problems with society. He was an older man with a steady relationship and had been through a lot. He encouraged me to seek male companionship.

The summer before my senior year I went to a rock concert with some girl friends. We met the members of the band and one of them asked me to go out the next evening. That was Cecil. He played the guitar, sang, and doubled on the synthesizer. We fell in love and I became his “lady”. I told him right away that I was a boy. He was very surprised but very sensitive and understanding. Since the band was on tour he would be away for several months at a time but we kept in touch by phone. Whenever he had a break he would fly in and spend time with me. The first time we had sex it was fantastic and I knew I would never think of being male again.

When I graduated I joined the band so we could be together always. When the band is not working we stay at his parents house on Long Island. His parents know about me, but it is all okay as they are very liberal, loving people. I am so lucky. The band is not one of the big names—yet. But, things are going well and we do make good money. I work as a secretary and assistant to the band’s agent and manager. This means helping

with tour arrangements, taking care of the instruments and sound equipment, and all the details that go into a successful rock band.

I also design and sew some of the costumes, arrange music, and do choreography if they need it. There are six members of the band including Cecil—four men and two women. My best friend is the wife of the lead guitarest. We go shopping together for clothes. Sometimes we cook for everyone and have parties. The band travels in converted buses and vans. We are like gypsies—on the road eight or nine months a year. It has been exciting but sometimes I really get tired of the driving and constant living out of a suitcase. But, travel can be educational. This week we are in Washington, D.C., and I am having such fun visiting all the museums and monuments. I even went on a tour of the White House (dressed in my linen suit, silk blouse, and hat).

My lover Cecil likes me best in frilly feminine things like garter belts and slinky dresses. He is always buying me little gifts of perfume, jewelry, undies and the like. On nights off we like to get dressed up and go to a fancy restaurant and then dancing or to the theatre or a concert. Of course, I enjoy dressing up, having my hair and nails done, putting on my makeup and jewelry, to go out with my man and strut my stuff. But, a lot of times, I’m content to just tie my hair back, put on a pair of jeans and a tee shirt and be plain and simple Sarah.

My lover paid for an operation to have my breasts enlarged. My measurements are now 36-24-34. I have not yet had the operation to make me a woman. Cecil has grown to like me with a penis and says I’m enough woman for him as it is. Of

course, I’m so full of female hormones I can’t get a very good erection, but I still have lots of sensitivity, and my lover gives me all the attention I can handle. There are times when I long to be a whole person one way or the other, but I guess I will stay this way for the time being.

I know that many people have a certain image of rock bands and the kind of life members of the band lead. Well, I want you to know that in our group there is no use of drugs and two of our guys don’t even drink or smoke. We may dress a little flamboyantly for business reasons but actually we are just normal people. Several of us are into health foods and jogging. We also play tennis and ski in the winter. Cecil likes to lift weights and has a terrific physique. He works out almost every day wherever we go.

Last Halloween the band threw a costume party for some close friends and fans. I talked Cecil into crossdressing for the first time. Some of the other guys were doing the same so he was in good company. But, it took some talking. He is so hung up on masculinity. I made an evening gown for him and got all the underwear and accessories together. I gave him a permanent wave and did his makeup. He had to shave his legs, chest, and arms. When he was all fixed up it was such a sight to see his broad shoulders and muscle-bound arms in a flowing evening dress. He had a lot of trouble with his high heels and I nearly cracked up watching him. He had to endure a lot of teasing but it was really a fun evening. I had a tuxedo made up and acted as his escort. But I wore my hair as usual, jewelry, makeup, and heels. So we were like a pair of lesbian girls with me as the butch and

Cecil as the femme. I called him Cecilia all night and treated him like a girl whenever I could get away with it.

This experience has added a new dimension to our sex life. Cecil discovered how much fun it could be to dress up and pretend to be a girl although he swears he would never do it full time. It is just as well because Cecil is not exactly dainty—6'2" tall and weighs about 220. In any event, after the costume party we bought him some girl's panties to wear. He has always had a strong fetish for my undies, but they are too small for him to wear. For his birthday I got him a garter belt with some fancy hose. These things really turn him on. He wants to get a negligee and some high heels as well. My girlfriends heard this and asked if I was afraid Cecil would wind up going all the way. I said that would be fine. I want whatever Cecil wants for himself. But, I doubt he will go much further. He enjoys his masculinity too much. Except for the costume party he has only warm feminine clothing to bed.

I had never seen your publication until recently. Of course, I knew there were such people as female impersonators, transvestites, and transsexuals. Cecil went into a bookstore in Times Square one day and bought several magazines on the subject. Your publication was the best and now we look for it everywhere we go. I am glad you are publishing. It is important for the public to know more about us and to realize we are not sexual freaks—but real human beings. We have as much to offer society as anyone.

Eventually Cecil and I want to retire from the rock scene and settle down somewhere as man and wife. We hope to adopt children. Cecil would like to go

to college and I dream of being a mother and a housewife. Or I might go to work as a secretary. In a few years we should have enough money saved to do this.

I just realized what a long letter this is. I am waiting for Cecil to come back and pick me up so we can go shopping—he's late so I just keep writing. Best wishes and please keep up the good work.



After winning contests in her hometown of Rockford, Illinois, the glitter of Hollywood was Karen's next stop for the glamorous action she thrives on.





close contact with her—as close as possible short of direct bodily and sexual contact.

He didn't think that he himself wanted to *be* a woman, but rather that when he was dressed as one and he saw his reflection in the mirror, what he saw was sufficiently feminine to trigger off his sexual urge.

How long he would have gone on reflecting on the article and his own position it is impossible to say, but at that moment, his thoughts were interrupted by Jan coming into the sitting-room. She was wearing the black short dress he so much admired her in, dark-tan tights and a pair of white evening sandals.


She seemed quite cheerful and had apparently forgotten about the slip, for she immediately began to talk about their weekend arrangements.

PUBLIC SPEAKING

Hello, this is Linda Lee. For the past couple of years I've been contributing articles to *MIMICS* on such subjects as make-up, hair, making contact with other transgendered people, coming out of the closet and so on.

Finally, after several years, something really colossal has happened.

I've run out of subjects!

At any rate, I've run out of subjects that would, on their own, form the basis for a whole article without a lot of padding (you should pardon the expression)

To narrow it down even further, I've run out of subjects that I can write about primarily from personal experience, or at least from

experience that I have knowledge of first-hand. To me this seems the only really valid sort of writing in a situation like this where you and I share a common interest and the only real reason I happen to be the one writing the articles is that I've done a number of things that people seems to be interested in.

"Does this," I hear you ask, "mean that you're going to stop writing?"

"No," I answer, to the intense disappointment of those who think these pages could better be filled with another pictorial on Heather Fontaine (a thought with which, I might add, I occasionally agree.)

What it does mean is that, unless I suddenly have an inspiration for another topic that will require a whole article, or unless one of you clever readers can suggest such a topic (that I feel qualified to write about), the format of my contribution to these issues will change somewhat and rather than a single subject, I'll cover a variety of things at whatever length I think appropriate.

I hope this meets with your approval. If not, my apologies. Or, as we in the jet set say, "Tough toenails."

. . .

One of the things I'm occasionally asked is how I can stand to speak on the topic of transgenderism.

"Well," as Mortimer Snerd used to say, "it ain't easy."

Someone did a survey a few years back to determine people's strongest fears. The survey discovered the fear of public speaking ranked ahead of things like death and divorce.

"Fear of public speaking ranks ahead of things like fear of divorce and fear of death!"

I'd guess this is because everyone has to die and divorce, when the situation requires it, can seem almost as inevitable. Public speaking, though, is generally something that can be avoided.

So most people do.

Ever since I can remember I've been interested in theatre and for most of my life, one way and another, I've made it my work.

But being on stage speaking someone else's words is a very different thing to standing in front of people and letting them see me and answering their questions, sometimes very intimate questions, about the most private and personal side of my life.

To give you a bit of an idea what it's like, I'm going to structure the rest of this part of my article in a question and answer format, rather like what I encounter when I speak in public. Ah, I see a hand in the back row . . .

Why do you speak in public, if it's so tough?

Well, I feel someone has to and, frankly, I'd rather people see me than some of the people they might see.

Why does anyone have to do it?

This answer is based on a personal judgment, but it's a judgment I share with many people. Unless people are out there talking about transgenderism to the public, then transgendered people aren't going to make any progress at all.

It's disheartening how little the average person (and this includes the average doctor, therapist or counselor unless they have somehow been brought into contact with the subject) knows about transgendered people.

What's even worse, what most people "know" about the subject is

often superficial, inaccurate or, at worst, distorted because the most widely available media sources are things like REAL PEOPLE, VEGAS and DRESSED TO KILL. In these the emphasis is on the carnival side-show approach (Look at the weirdos . . .) rather than any attempt at sensitivity or empathy.

What can you do to change that?

My aim, whenever I talk to a group, is to get them to accept me as a person. This involves working past all the labels and misconceptions and it isn't always easy to accomplish. Indeed it isn't possible to do it every time for every person in the audience, but that's what I aim for.

But why you? Why not leave it to someone else?

That's a tempting idea upon occasion, but a number of reasons keep me from succumbing to it.

First, I have no axe to grind, nothing to sell, no pet theory to push, nobody to discredit. It think this is very important. It means that people can hear what I have to say without the thought that I have a vested interest (or even a transvested interest) in being up there. I'm there only because I want people to become sensitive to this issue.

Some of you know that I produced a cassette tape based on my own experiences and observations as a transgendered person. The tape has been on sale through these pages (see plug at end of article) as well as through other outlets in the transgendered community. Yet I never even mention this tape when I speak because I don't want to discredit myself by having something to sell.

To the same end, I steer clear from any "far out" explanation of the transgender phenomenon. I have seen a speaker have an audience fairly well with her and then, in the space of a few minutes, alienate a substantial number of them by trying to tie transgenderism to the concept of reincarnation.

There is certainly a place for that theory, as there should be for all theories, but an introductory talk on transgenderism, which is itself a controversial topic for a lay audience, is not that place. So, just as I don't sell a product, I don't sell a theory either.

Likewise I try not to deluge the audience with technical terms. I always mention one or two books for anyone who has an interest in pursuing the subject further, but apart from that I try to keep the talk on a human level—one person (me) telling another person (them) what this whole thing feels like from my point of view.

My hope is to create some feeling of the common humanity we share and I find I can do that lots better telling about the time my family caught me at age 14 or so fully "dressed" than I can by explaining that Dr. Stoller theorizes that mothers of transsexual boys had weak father figures.

Apart from having no axe to grind, another reason I'd rather be speaking to groups than having them hear some other people is that I try to keep a sense of humor about the subject. I've seen speakers who could reduce an audience within minutes to a state of shuddering dread about the whole topic because the incidents they chose to consider were so unrelievedly gloomy.

Yes, there are horror stories and certainly every transgendered person suffers indignities and setbacks, sometimes severe ones. But unless there is an overall feeling of perspective a speaker can hardly be surprised if the audience "tunes out."

What does that have to do with humor?

What humor does is allow us to see things as no more important than they really are. A man at my last talk complimented me on my sense of humor and I told him that years ago I'd figured out that I could either keep my sense of humor on the subject or get suicidal and I thought the former was a better bet.

Still, my worst failing is probably that I sometimes let the absurdity of the situation obscure the real difficulties and heartaches that can be part of it.

The task is to give a balanced picture that neither overwhelms the audience nor gives the impression that the problem is trivial.

What's the hardest part of your talks?

The hardest part is the questions because they can be very tough to answer and very personal. But this can also be the most exciting part for me because this is where I may learn something, either about the way the audience sees transgendered people or about myself, in the course of answering someone's question.

One reason this is a possibility is that I made a deal with myself when I first started speaking in public that I wouldn't duck any question no matter how personal or difficult. The only exception I allow myself is when an absolutely honest answer to a question might embarrass someone else, which I don't feel I have a right to do.

The groups I've spoken to have either been largely professional people or have been college students taking classes in human sexuality or related topics. As a result most of the questions are, if not terribly well informed, at least sincere and on the level. Very seldom is anything asked to embarrass or harass.

I try to tape every talk I give or panel I'm on so I can get a sense of what questions are most often asked and where the greatest areas of misinformation lie. The more I've found out about the basic areas of confusion, the more I've changed my introductory remarks to touch on these things.

Probably the thing that confuses people more than anything else is that the whole situation of transsexuality doesn't really have much to do with sex.

What in the world do you mean?

Transsexuality really has to do with identity, specifically gender identity. It has no bearing at all on who one would choose as a sex partner, whether one is passive or active with that partner or, indeed, whether one is sexual at all.

Some people have a very difficult time, for instance, accepting that even though I'm transsexual my primary attraction is, far and away, to other women or at least to other feminine people. I explain that one of the things I have to be most careful of in public is how I look at other women, because there are learned cultural differences in the way a man can look at a woman and the way a woman can look at a woman.

The whole question of sexuality vs. gender, or rather sexuality as a separate question from gender is probably the most difficult thing to make clear to a lay audience, but it's one of the most important.

What are some of the others?

Another tricky area is the amount of variation among transgendered people. Most audiences aren't aware that the definitions are much less rigid than were once thought and that there is a great deal of variation even among the people who define themselves as, say, transsexual.

For instance, it puzzles some listeners that a person could consider him or herself transsexual yet not care about getting the genital surgery. As this is the situation I am in, this question is almost bound to come up when I talk and it's very difficult to explain especially since nobody really knows the "why" for sure and all we can do is make educated guesses.

That's fairly personal, all right. Aren't you embarrassed to talk about something like that?

The questions aren't usually designed to be embarrassing, but it's almost inevitable we'll touch on some very personal subjects such as choice of sex partners, how I behave in a relationship and so on. These are legitimate questions and deserve an honest answer because they can help clarify for people what a transsexual is and isn't.

How do people react to the way you look?

It still amazes me that the audience often expects a transsexual to look like a man in a dress. Many people have expressed surprise after the talk that I turned out to be the speaker when they initially thought I was one of the students coming to hear the talk.

Partly I think this comes, again, from media inaccuracy. So often male to female transgendered people are portrayed either as grotesque parodies of women or as super glamorous, rhinestones in the eyelashes, and that sort of thing, that people are surprised when I don't look much different from most of the women in the audience.

I have to admit that I do try to dress to blend in with the students because if I can shatter some of their preconceptions before I even begin to speak, it is a step in the right direction.

The less they find I fit their stereotypes, the more they will have to regard me as a person, and that is the beginning of what I hope to accomplish.

There are some people, of course, who simply can't accept me. Their prejudices are so strong and they are somehow so uncomfortable inside themselves, so "Not O.K." to borrow a phrase from Transactional Analysis, that they cannot accept anyone or anything that doesn't conform to their conceptions of how things ought to be.

I often think that people who are really made intensely uncomfortable by transgenderism probably have, buried away somewhere in their unconscious, some sort of gender conflict of their own. Otherwise the subject wouldn't touch such a raw nerve.

Perhaps an analogy could be made to the person who has no prejudice against interracial marriage until his daughter brings home her black boyfriend. At this point the subject is suddenly close and threatening so it can bring out a strong negative reaction that has been buried.

You mean because the person hadn't had to deal with it directly before?

Right. It seems likely that a person wouldn't react so strongly unless there seemed to be a direct threat. If we feel confident enough to deal with a situation it won't bother us that much.

Of course people who really can't tolerate even the mention of the subject are, luckily, rare and I generally find the positive reactions far greater than the negative reactions.

Of course you are dealing with some heavy issues. Does that have an effect on attitudes?

Somewhat, but remember that not all the questions are so basic and serious. Certain questions come up every time, or almost every time and they're not all so earth-shaking.

Such as?

Well, probably the two most-asked questions are: "Which bathroom do you use in a public place?" and "What do you do if you want to go to the beach?"

Probably the next most asked are questions about estrogen therapy, what it does and so on. In fact the question that "gets to me" more than any other usually comes up at this point.

So what is it?

I was afraid you'd ask. It comes in two forms. If I haven't mentioned that I've been on estrogen nearly seven years, someone occasionally asks, "Are you on estrogen?"

If I have mentioned that I am on estrogen they'll ask, "Have you had any results from it?" and I have to gloomily admit that some of us

aren't so lucky as the ones who "blossom" right away or very amply. I explain that, yes, I have developed, but, no, not nearly as much as I'd hoped.

Generally this leads to a question about silicone to enlarge the breasts and I explain the danger of injected silicone and the drawbacks of implants.

Very often some of the women in the audience will try to console me by mentioning that many genetic women are small, and I explain that it's not the results themselves so much as the results contrasted to the amount of money, time and effort I've put into them.

Is the public fairly knowledgeable about things like estrogen and implants?

The women are pretty knowledgeable about implants because, I suppose, so many consider their breasts are too small, an inferiority feeling this society fosters, I'm afraid. One of the things I try to make clear is that I don't want to be a Loni Anderson, I'd just like to fit my clothes better and that sort of thing. Indeed, I explain that one reason I've never gone ahead with implants is that, in order for them to work right they would have to be bigger than I really want. That surprises a lot of people.

It is really surprising how little information the general public has about transsexuals. One common question is whether transsexuals can bear children. I explain that the surgery is purely cosmetic from that standpoint and tell them that anyone who figures out a way for a genetic male to give birth will become rich and famous indeed.

One of the areas where most people aren't clear, as I mentioned before, is the question of sexual identity vs. gender identity vs. sexual preference.

"Sexual identity is what's between your legs; gender identity is what's in your head."

How do you explain that to laymen?

It's not really such a tough concept. Primarily the problem is that nobody's brought it to their attention before.

To make it very basic, sexual identity is what's between your legs; gender identity is what's in your head and sexual preference is who you like to go to bed with and how.

I go on to elaborate that, while some transsexuals are strictly heterosexual (in terms of their gender of choice), others are strictly homosexual, while still others (the majority, I believe) are bisexual, yet this all has nothing whatever to do with the fact that their gender identity is different from the sexual identity they were born with.

Part of the misconception around these areas comes from the confusion of "drag" with both transvestitism and transsexuality.

I explain that, while all three involve wearing the clothes of the opposite sex, it is the reason for which they are worn that makes them different.

Well, what are the reasons?

Okay. A transvestite cross-dresses because doing so gives some sort of sexual or psychic relief.

A transsexual cross-dresses because the clothes happen to coincide with the gender identity, but the clothes by themselves aren't a primary concern. To a transvestite, they are.

In contrast someone who does drag may do so for a variety of reasons, but none of them are internal. That is, someone may cross-dress for a lark (as at Halloween), or for business (as in the case of a professional impersonator) or to attract sex partners (as some gay males do). But unless the cross-dressing has some internal value the person doing it is neither transvestite nor transsexual but simply "doing drag".

Unfortunately that aspect of drag that concerns a male attracting other males has crept over (sort of like a fungus) and become associated with both transsexuals and transvestites, largely, again, because of media inaccuracy on the subject. To someone exposed to this over a long period it never occurs that, perhaps, a transsexual might not be attracted to men.

Why has the media done this?

Well, first of all, I don't mean to give the impression that it's deliberate. Media people are just like most other people; they don't have a lot of accurate information on the subject either.

Then, too, some media exposure has been very good. Merv Griffin and Phil Donohue have both done segments devoted to the subject and have shown themselves as sensitive to the issues surrounding it.

The worst offenders are writers of fiction scripts who portray the subject with gross inaccuracy, usually associating cross-dressing, for no scientifically valid reason, with all sorts of other exotic mental aberrations.

Who can forget Norman/Norma Bates from Hitchcock's brilliant film of Robert Bloch's PSYCHO (though to be fair, the film never labeled Norman as a transvestite), various transgendered villains in television shows from STREETS OF SAN FRANCISCO to CHARLIE'S ANGELS, and, of course, the crazed "transsexual" psychiatrist in DRESSED TO KILL.

The fact that the murderer in DRESSED TO KILL was not a transsexual at all, but a criminal sexual psychopath with a definite personality split did not seem to bother Brian DePalma one bit. Is it any wonder that a transvestite would be reluctant to admit he enjoys cross-dressing when, to do so might inspire his wife or girlfriend to hide the kitchen knives and refuse to ride in elevators with him?

I do believe that writers have more of an obligation than they have shown in the past to portray transgendered characters, if not sympathetically (no one, after all, has the right to insist that any group be portrayed as "good guys") at least with some regard for the accuracy with which their transgenderism is depicted.

Of course it is at least partly up to transgendered people to voice their objections when we see the subject distorted in television or films, and, conversely, to applaud when it is portrayed accurately and sensitively. Network executives generally believe that each letter actually written represents several thousand people with the same general opinion. So, letters, so long as they are reasonable in tone and content can make a difference.

In a way this brings me back to my original point. The speaking I do is another aspect of the same process as writing a letter. If we don't educate the public, it won't get done.

. . .

Well, here I am at the end of my space having made a fibber out of myself by filling this article, mostly, with one topic. Oh, well.

BATTLE OF THE V.I.P.'s




